Standard Operating Procedure on Prevention/Management of COVID-19 at Paradip Port

Captain/Master of the Vessel is advised to impress upon his crews/ passengers as follows;

You will receive daily calls/visit from PPT to ask about your health status for the day, kindly cooperate with them. You are requested to self-monitor for development of symptoms suggestive of COVID-19, i.e. Fever and Cough etc., following departure from the Ports of Republic of China, Iran, Italy, South Korea and Japan, on or after 1st February, 2020 and/or departure from the Ports of other affected countries within the last 14 days and/or any person coming in contact with suspected/confirmed case/Health worker taking care of sick within the last 14 days.


Master of the vessels shall arrange for your body-temperature recording twice-daily for the purpose of reporting to the PPT Authorities, at least for 3 days preceding to the arrival at Paradip Port Limit, until departure.

In case of onset of symptoms (fever and cough etc.), put on a face mask immediately, restrict your outdoor movement, and contact your Steamer Agent/HM/DC/CMO/PHO of Paradip Port, during stay at the Paradip Port; and /or contact
